## School Dress Code

As we look forward to more sunshine, it is a good time to review the Seaview Dress Code guidelines.

*"Students are expected to dress in a manner that is appropriate and conducive to a positive and safe learning environment. At school we rely on the good sense of students and their parents rather than a strict code as to what is suitable to wear to school. These are some general guidelines:*

- a. *Hats are not worn in the building*
- b. *Beach wear/leisure wear or clothes that are revealing are not acceptable (i.e. low cut tops, spaghetti straps, muscle t-shirts, halter tops, bare midriffs, bare backs.)*
- c. *Items of clothing that display offensive graphics/writing are not appropriate for school*
- d. *Shorts/skirts should be, at a minimum, of a reasonable mid- thigh length*
